Throw all biodegradable trash in the trash bin on Figueroa in front of the studio (otherwise we get ants & mice & other icky creatures)

If you produce a lot of trash, please throw it out in the bin on Figueroa Street or take it with you when you leave (we do not have access to trash & recycling bins here)

Remove staples, nails or screws from the walls

Patch, fill and paint any holes in the walls

Vacuum and mop floor

Touch up floor with floor paint if you've done anything to remove it

Wash your dishes

Leave bathroom clean

Turn off AC & heat

Return key to lockbox
